

Welcome to Willow Class - 2016/2017

Items needed in school each day: Reading book, Homework Diary, P.E. kit named (plain navy / black shorts, plain red / white t-shirt, plimsolls, trainers and tracksuit for outdoor games & lessons)

Home Learning is set as follows:

Reading ~



Children are expected to read daily and record their reading in their diary. Competent readers must maintain their reading diet in order to reach high targets by the end of Year 6. Children should still read to adults at home and parents / carers should continue to ask children questions about the text (see 'A quick guide to reading in Willow Class'). Please try to read with your child often and add a comment in the diary if you wish. *If you are able to pop in during the week to hear children read this would be much appreciated. Please come in to arrange a mutually convenient time.*

English Home Learning ~ Each child will have an English Home Learning folder / book. English Home Learning will be set on **weeks that children do not have Talk for Big Write**; it will be set on a Thursday and should be handed in to Mrs Sassis the following Monday. This term the



English Home Learning will focus on writing, SPAG (spag.com) and sometimes it may be topic or science related. When the Home Learning focus is writing, children will be expected to produce quality writing in no more than 2 to 3 paragraphs. As always, children should use their best presentation for their Home Learning.

WOW writing will be set once every half term and this is an opportunity for *extended quality* writing. Children will have two weeks to complete each WOW task.

Spelling ~



A **spelling book** will be sent home each **Thursday** with new spellings to be learnt by your child. This spelling book must be returned to school each **Wednesday**. The spellings to be learnt are taken from the Year 5/6 Statutory Word list and it is expected that children will practise these spellings using the 'Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check' strategy and write sentences for some of these words as appropriate. Each Wednesday children will be given a short dictation to test their spellings.

'Talk for Big Write' Home Learning ~ 'Big Write' sessions are independent writing sessions where the children get the chance to write and practise using the English skills we have been rehearsing in class (VCOP - descriptive vocabulary, connectives, different ways to open a sentence and punctuation). Please spend some time with your child to share their ideas about **VCOP** that they can use in their writing. *Children are expected to use the back of the Talk for Big Write page for planning or note-making, so that they prepare ideas that they can use in their writing. The completed, signed sheet should be returned to school ready for the children to use during their Big Write.* This will act as a framework to structure their thinking or as a tool to help them remember to use interesting vocabulary when they write.



Maths ~ Each child will have a Maths Home Learning folder. Work will be set on a **Thursday** and should be handed in to **Mrs Tweedale** the following **Monday**. Maths Home Learning will be differentiated and children will be expected to **complete two sections** every week. Children will be praised for their effort, not just the right answers! Please encourage your child to show their working out and use best presentation. Maths Home Learning should be completed in pencil unless otherwise stated. Children should also regularly practise their times tables and be able to recall these facts at speed. We encourage the use of www.mathletics.co.uk and Hit the Button on www.topmarks.co.uk

PE / Games / Swimming / Gymnastics
