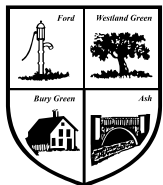

Disappointing Response

As previously advised, last week's newsletter, which was a very detailed one, was emailed out with a 'Read Receipt' request to ascertain parental involvement. I am very disappointed to announce that out of **102 families**, only **21 families** opened the newsletter with 15 other families receiving a paper copy. That equates to **7 KS1 families and 14 KS2 families**, giving an overall **20%** of families supporting the electronic newsletter. Whilst some parents may elect to access the newsletter via the website, it is still a very small number of parents engaging in the communication, which is a key aspect of our Home /School Agreement, signed by parents at the beginning of the year. Communication should be a 2-way process and we will continue to run 'Read Receipts' on random weeks over the remainder of the term to gauge improvement.
