Great to see so many of you in church yesterday - the children were so happy to sing to you!

The children will all be bringing home a sunflower tonight, that they have planted today. This marks the beginning of our new 'GROWING' theme Please help them to look after it and bring it back into school after Easter.

Ash children have all got some tasks to complete over the Easter break. They have made a book and need some encouragement to record whatever they like in it over the next two weeks. They can write a story or a diary or just fill it with lists - whatever they feel like. The important thing is that they have ownership of the book and can tell us about it and read it to us when they return to school. Encourage them to have their letter strips in front of them whenever they are writing. Practising their names is an important thing to do - everyday if you can! This can be done on paper, with paint, in mud, in condensation, wherever and whenever you can imagine. Some of the children are bringing home a whiteboard for this purpose. The children have also got a number game, which will require at least one die - we hope you can all find one somewhere.

As we have mentioned before it really would be good now if the Saplings could attend for at least four sessions a week. This is in preparation for school in September when they will all be expected to attend for five full days.

We return to school on Tuesday 18 April and look forward to seeing you all then. **Saplings Lunch Club will resume that day. Ash children will need to bring their PE kits back to school that day too.**
