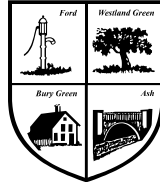

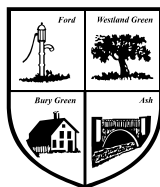
Class E-safety Agreement 2017

- ✓ I will only use ICT in school for school purposes.
- ✓ I will only use my class email address with my teacher's approval.
- ✓ I will only open e-mail attachments from people I know, or who my teacher has approved.
- ✓ I will not give out my own/others details such as name, phone number or home address. I will not arrange to meet someone or send my image.
- ✓ I will support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset any member of the school community.
- ✓ I will not sign up for any online service.
- ✓ I will not tell other people my ICT passwords.
- ✓ I will only open/delete my own files.
- ✓ I will make sure that all ICT contact with other children and adults is responsible, polite and sensible.
- ✓ I will not access social media sites at school.
- ✓ I will not deliberately look for, save or send anything that could be unpleasant or nasty. If I accidentally find anything like this, I will tell my teacher immediately.
- ✓ I will only access the internet through Google on the home page of The Herts Grid.
- ✓ I will be responsible for my behaviour when using ICT because I know that these rules are to keep me safe.
- ✓ I know that my use of ICT can be checked and that my parent/ carer may be contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about my e-Safety by not keeping this agreement.
