

<p>SCIENCE: We will be continuing to work scientifically by observing, reasoning, asking questions, investigating, testing and recording. We will talk about, basic needs for survival, food chains and different classifications of animals (mammals, reptiles, insects and birds). We will learn about humans, naming and locating different parts of the body, looking at the human skeleton and learning how we keep healthy.</p>	<p>HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY: We will learn about Continents and oceans, find them on the map and then look at Europe. We will look at each of the countries from our Alice In Wonderland project, including the UK and NI and learn about some key features of each.
