

<p>English</p> <p>Lime Class will be working on report-writing, note-taking, biographical texts and poetry. Lime Class will be working on spelling patterns and have opportunities throughout the week to improve their application of these. They will work on types of sentences and the grammar relating to these. The children will be reading and interrogating texts every week using questions to help them find proof to back up their ideas. Lime will also be working hard on improving their handwriting.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Lime will continue working on a wide variety of skills, including their understanding of number, estimation and measuring. They will build on their mental fluency in addition and subtraction and they will be improving their knowledge of times tables and the related division facts. The children will be working on shape, including understanding angle and position.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Lime are going to be finding out how to define and sort animals and plants into groups. We will find out about coral, including The Great Barrier Reef. We will look at how environments change and the problems this poses in the oceans. The children will be using various Scientific skills such as observation, both written and sketched, fair testing and classifying. They will have the chance to select Scientific equipment such as magnifiers and thermometers.</p>
<p>RE</p> <p>Lime Class will be looking at the beliefs, practices, symbols and actions of two religions, Islam and Christianity.</p> <p>PSHE</p> <p>Lime will be looking at keeping safe while using the Internet.
