<p><b>Y5 Test 23/1</b> <b>Words ending in</b> <b>'-able' and '-ible'</b></p> <p>comfortable, dependable, enjoyable, horrible, incredible, possible, reasonable, reliable, terrible, understandable</p>	<p><b>Y5 Test 30/1</b> <b>Words ending in</b> <b>'-ably' and '-ibly'</b></p> <p>comfortably, dependably, horribly, incredibly, legibly, possibly, reliably, sensibly, terribly, visibly</p>	<p><b>Y5 Test 6/2</b> <b>Words ending in '-able',</b> <b>where the 'e' from the root</b> <b>word remains</b></p> <p>agreeable, changeable, irreplaceable, knowledgeable, manageable, microwaveable, noticeable, rechargeable, replaceable, salvageable</p>
